Keeping in view the averments made in the application, which are duly supported by an affidavit, the application is allowed and on the joint request of learned counsel for the parties, the main writ petition is taken up for hearing today itself.

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1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue raised in the present petition has already been decided by the Coordinate Bench of this Court while passing order in ***CWP No.6169 of 2017 titled as Bagga Ram vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 11.09.2023***, which judgment has already been implemented and therefore, the present petition be also disposed of in same terms.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents raise no objection about the said fact.

3. Keeping in view the fact that the parties are agreed that the issue raised in the present petition is covered by the decision of this Court in ***Bagga Ram's case (supra)***, the present writ petition is also disposed of in terms of the decision in ***Bagga Ram's case (supra)***.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to the claim of the petitioner for the grant of proficiency step up, the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents by filing

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appropriate representation.
