Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023, is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.17 dated 14.03.2025 registered under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 351(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023, at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala.

Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Karnail Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Bholath, Kapurthala, today in the Court which is taken on record and he, at the very outset, on instructions from ASI Manjeet Singh, submits that the arrest of the petitioner is not required as after examining the veracity of the allegations against the petitioner, a cancellation report has been prepared and the same has been approved by concerned Superintendent of Police (Headquarter) and the cancellation report will be submitted before the jurisdictional Court within a period of 06 weeks from today.
