1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners for grant of pay scale of Rs.1200-2040 w.e.f. 01.05.1990 alongwith all consequential benefits as has been granted to other T-mates working in the department.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner(s) contends that the issue involved in the present case is covered by the judgment dated 25.03.2025 passed by a Division Bench of this Court in **CWP-11710-2014** titled as '**Sarbans Singh and others** Vs. **State of Haryana and others**' and other connected case(s). He contends that with regards to their claim, the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 05.02.2011 (Annexure P-4) upon the respondents and he would be satisfied in case respondent(s) are directed to consider and decide the said legal notice in accordance with law as well as in view of the judgment dated 25.03.2025 passed in CWP-11710-2014.



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3. Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid factual position.

4. Accordingly, the present petition is **disposed of** with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case with a direction to respondent(s)-authorities to take note of the legal notice dated 05.02.2011 (Annexure P-4) served by the petitioner(s) in accordance with law as well as in view of the judgment dated 25.03.2025 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in **Sarbans Singh and others** (**supra**) expeditiously and preferably within a period of 03 months.

5. Needless to mention that if upon considering the claim of the petitioner(s), in case, any monetary benefit is found due and payable to the petitioner(s), the same shall be disbursed in their favour within a further period of **02** month.

6. All pending civil misc. application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
