The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to constitute Special Investigation Team (SIT) of some senior police officers from outside the district or to hand over the investigation to some independent agency.

The learned State counsel, at the very outset, on instructions from ASI Jeevan Lal, submits that nothing survives in the present petition and the Investigating Agency has already concluded the investigation and the outcome of the investigation in the shape of final report under Section 193 of BNSS (earlier Section 173 of Cr.P.C.) would be submitted before the jurisdictional Court within a period of 04 weeks.

In view of the the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed in the present case and the same is disposed of accordingly. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to invoke his alternative appropriate remedy as available to him in accordance with law for redressal of any surviving grievance.
