SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 08.02.2023, passed by this Court in CWP-8044-2021.

2. The relevant portion of order dated 08.02.2023, passed by this Court in CWP-8044-2021 is reproduced as under:-

“Since an apprehension has been raised by the learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioner in CWP No.8044 of 2021 that Current Duty Charge would be handed over to persons, who are ineligible on their passing of written examination, the result as declared will not be acted upon, till final decision is taken as to whether candidates, who have



cleared the written examination, would be entitled to hold Current Duty/Additional/Regular Charge.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the main writ petition is decided with certain directions.
4. Consequently, the present petition is hereby ***dismissed***.
5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
