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LISA GILL, J.

1. Petitioner has filed this writ petition being aggrieved of proceedings under Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002, initiated against him by respondent-financial institution.

2. Following order was passed on the last date of hearing:-

*“Present writ petition is filed against private non-banking financial institution. Vide order dated 05.09.2023, writ petition was adjourned at request of learned counsel for petitioner, while observing that in case arguments are not addressed on the next date of hearing, interim order in favour of petitioner shall automatically stand vacated.*

*This writ petition was taken up for hearing on 10.01.2024, when the same was yet again adjourned at request of learned counsel for petitioner.*
