The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner(s) seeking issuance of an appropriate writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 07.01.2025 (Annexure P-18) as well as for directing respondent No.7 to submit a proper verification report regarding the sports gradation certificate of the petitioner to the concerned authority.

2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that as regards the grievances mentioned in the petition, the petitioner(s) has already sent a representation dated 07.01.2025 (Annexure P-18) to respondent No.3 and he would be satisfied, in case, the said respondent is directed to consider and decide the said representation by passing a well reasoned and speaking order in a time bound manner.



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3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Rahul Dev, Addl. AG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

With the consent of the parties, the present petition is accordingly disposed of without commenting on the merits of the present case and with a direction to **Respondent No.7 – Director General of Sports & Youth Affairs, Haryana**, to send the verification report(s) of the sports gradation certificate of the petitioner to the concerned Department preferably within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Upon receipt of the said verification report, **Respondent No.3 – Director General, Human Resources Department (Common Cadre Group-D), Haryana**, shall consider and decide the representation dated 07.01.2025 (Annexure P-18) by passing a well reasoned and speaking order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties, in accordance with law, within a further period of 01 month thereafter.
