Prayer in the present petition has been made seeking interim regular bail for to the petitioner in case FIR No.145 dated 18.07.2023, registered at Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana under Sections 302, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC, for a period of 10 days to complete the formalities, since the wedding ceremony of the petitioner is scheduled for 04.06.2025.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is behind bars in the above mentioned FIR. He submits the marriage of the petitioner is fixed for 04.06.2025 and thus, he be granted interim regular bail for a period of 10 days, for the said purpose.

Vide order dated 27.05.2025, respondent-State was directed to verify the facts and file the status report.

In compliance thereof, status report dated 28.05.2025 has been filed by the State by way of affidavit of Mr. Shivraj Singh Nandgarh, PPS, Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana, which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

A perusal of the status report would show that family members of the petitioner are not even aware about the proposed marriage. However, the petitioner is in custody in above mentioned FIR.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the present case and keeping in view the status report, this Court does not find any merit in the petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
