1. Prayer in the present petition has been made for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 & 5 and for not harassing the petitioners on any false criminal complaint, if any, lodged by the private respondent or any of their relatives. Further prayer has been made for directing the official respondents to decide the representation (Annexure P-5).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 & 5 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 & 5. Their marriage certificate and photographs evidencing their marriage has been placed on record. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioners have filed representation dated 25.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) before respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran.
3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

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4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Addl.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to decide the representation dated 25.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.

6. Disposed of.
