1. This petition for grant of anticipatory bail has been filed by petitioner, a co-accused in case bearing FIR No.81 dated 20.04.2025, registered against him at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot, at the instance of one Puran Singh, u/s 110, 333, 115(2), 324(4), 351(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS.

2. As per Status Report dated 08.07.2025 filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the petitioner has not cooperated in the investigation, when he was asked for recovery of weapon, he fled away. In para 9 of the Status Report, allegations have also been levelled against co-accused Jagmeet Singh for procuring a false FIR.

3. During the course of submission, it also came to the notice of the Court that petitioner has not appended a copy of the impugned order vide

which his application for grant of pre-arrest bail was dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge.

4. In the meanwhile, learned counsel for the complainant has also placed on record copies of orders dated 15.07.2025 and 22.08.2025 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-36605-2025 and CRM-M-43137-2025, respectively, vide which the bail applications of the similarly situated co-accused were dismissed.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn.
