SUKHVINDER KAUR, J. (Oral)

The present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, is for quashing of FIR No.79 dated 07.02.2018, under Sections 147, 148, 324, 506 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Bhiwani Sadar, Bhiwani, along with all other consequential proceedings arising out of the same in view of compromise (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 13.08.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua genuineness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Bhiwani, and got their statements recorded. On the basis of statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted his report dated 27.08.2025 and submitted that as per the

statement of the parties, the compromise (Annexure P-2) effected between them appears to be genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Learned State Counsel as well as counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 7 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR No.79 dated 07.02.2018.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench Judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, the present petition is *allowed* and FIR No.79 dated 07.02.2018, under Sections 147, 148, 324, 506 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Bhiwani Sadar, Bhiwani, along with all other consequential proceedings arising out of the same in view of compromise (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioners.
