JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. By this common order CWP-15640-2025 and CWP-15651-2025 are disposed of since issues involved in the above captioned petitions and prayer sought are common. With the consent of parties and for the sake of brevity, facts are borrowed from CWP-15640-2025.

2. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to decide the pending appeal No.60 of 2025 (Annexure P-2) dated 27.03.2025 in a time bound manner.



3. The petitioner claims that he was appointed as Salesman in Khurana PACS Ltd. Khurana. Valid agenda was placed before the Board on 08.09.2023 and was duly approved. There was concurrence of Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies, Kaithal to said agenda. There was another resolution dated 20.05.2024 regarding his pay scale. The Deputy Registrar Cooperative Societies, Kurukshetra vide order dated 19.02.2025 rescinded the resolution dated 09.06.2023 in exercise of power conferred by Section 27 of Haryana Cooperative Societies Act, 1984. The petitioner has preferred appeal against order of Deputy Registrar before Registrar Cooperative Societies. The appeal is pending before Appellate Authority.

4. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. AG, Haryana submits that Appellate Authority would decide stay application and appeal within the period as directed by this Court.

5. Without expressing any opinion on merit, the petitions stand disposed of with a direction to Registrar Cooperative Societies to decide aforesaid appeals within four months from today. The stay application, if any, filed by petitioners shall be decided within six weeks from today.
