In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner-Firm is that they are operating stage carriage services from Jalandhar to Moga and Pathankot back to Jalandhar but the timetable which has been fixed, is causing prejudice and the petitioner-Firm has already filed a legal notice dated 11.04.2025 (Annexure P-13) for the redressal of their grievance, which is not being looked into hence, respondents be directed to decide the said legal notice dated 11.04.2025 (Annexure P-13) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 11.04.2025 (Annexure P-13) has been received in the office of the concerned
