6. In view of the above limited prayer made and without commenting upon the merits of the case, let a copy of this petition be sent to Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner, U.T., Chandigarh (as the case may be) and



the complaint(s)/ representation(s) be decided under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, within a period of 15 days by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
