Seeking setting aside of the order dated 01.09.2015 whereby the claim of the petitioner for grant of technical pay scale was rejected, the instant writ petition has been filed by placing reliance on the judgment of a Division Bench of this Court in the matter of **Sarbans Singh and others Vs. The State of Haryana and others, CWP No.11710-2014, decided on 25.03.2025** along with other connected matters.

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2 It is evident from a perusal of the impugned order that the benefit had been denied to the petitioner after taking note of Section 4 of the Haryana Act No.1 of 2014. Undisputedly, the writ petitions challenging vires of the Act No.1 of 2014 were filed including **CWP No.11710-2014 titled as 'Sarbars Singh and others Vs. The State of Haryana and others'** and the same have been decided vide common judgment 25.03.2025.

3 Notice of motion.

4 Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana, enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He has no objection to the present petition being disposed of directing the respondents to decide the claim within a time bound manner.

5 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to decide the legal notice dated 20.04.2025 (Annexure P-14) and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law in terms of the facts pleaded herein as well as the aforesaid judgment passed by the Division Bench of this Court within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
