1. The prayer made in the present petition is for quashing the action of the respondents in treating the appointment of the petitioners against vacancies as empanelment and denying them benefit admissible to other temporary/contractual staff members and for grant of minimum of pay scale with DA.

2. Learned counsel submits that regarding the claim as raised in the present petition, a legal notice dated 07.03.2025, Annexure P-24, has been served upon respondents, to which a copy of letter/memo dated 22.04.2025 addressed by respondent No.1 to No.3 to take a decision regarding the same, was received by them, however, no action has been taken. He thus, on instructions prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner,

3. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

4. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to

decide the legal notice dated 07.03.2025, within a period of 6 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
