1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, directing the respondents to immediately process and reimburse the medical claims of chronic diseases in respect of petitioner's wife who is critically ill and dependent on daily life-saving medication treatment and submitted by the petitioner to the respondents of Rs. 104193/- dated 30.12.2024 (P-6), of Rs. 150480/- dated 19.02.2025 (P-7) and of Rs. 1256571- dated 11.04.2025 (P-8).
2. Learned State counsel has produced a copy of the communication dated 03.12.2025 issued by the Director General, Technical Education Department, Haryana, which is taken on record as document 'A'.

3. The pay order dated 24.06.2025 makes it evident that an amount of Rs. 2,76,141/- was released, and subsequently another amount of Rs. 1,24,902/- was also reimbursed to the petitioner on 04.06.2025.

4. In light of the above, no cause of action further survives for inviting interference or indulgence by this Court.

5. However, it is made clear that in case any amount still remains due, the petitioner shall be at liberty to make a necessary representation to respondent No. 2, which shall be decided within a period of six weeks thereafter.

6. The petition, in the aforesaid terms, stands disposed of, having been rendered infructuous.
