The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the order dated 16.04.2025, Annexure P-9, whereby the petitioners' claim for promotion to the post of High School Headmaster under Physically Handicapped (PH) quota has been rejected on the ground that the Department is in the process of issuing reversion notices to the juniors. These juniors were promoted as High School Headmaster vide order dated 27.02.2023, based upon this the petitioners had claimed promotion.

2. The grievance raised in the petition is that despite rejection of the petitioners' claim on the ground that the Department is in the process of issuing reversion notices to the juniors, it has not been done and instead, some of them have been further promoted as Principal.

3. Learned State counsel has received instructions from the second respondent vide memo dated 07.08.2025, which is retained on the case file as



Annexure ‘A’. Referring to the same, she contends that employees junior to the petitioners, as detailed in the instructions, have already been issued show cause notices for reversion dated 17.07.2025, and appropriate action will be taken against them in accordance with law.

4. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
5. Ordered accordingly.
6. In case the appropriate action in accordance with law is not taken by the Department, the petitioners will be at liberty to approach this Court.
