The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to step-up the pay of the petitioners at par with the juniors notionally from the date when they were promoted as Elementary School Headmaster (ESHM) and actually from the date they have joined as ESHM.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent no.3 is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 01.04.2025, Annexure P-10, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Rathee, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 01.04.2025, will be decided by respondent no.3-Director,



Elementary Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
