KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a direction upon respondents no.1 to 9 to ensure that respondents no.10 to 24 ply their buses as per the time table dated 04.01.2018 (Annexure P-12), issued by respondent no.4. The petitioners-Transport Societies, further seeks a direction upon respondents no.1 to 9 to take a strict action against respondents no.10 to 24.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners-Transport Societies submits that new joint time-table has been issued on dated 16.10.2023, and all bus operators, including the Haryana Roadways Transport Corporation (HRTC), have to strictly comply with the said time-table.

Whereas a specific direction has also been issued by the DTO-cum-Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Jhajjar at Bahadurgarh, to all General Managers of the concerned HRTC depot to ensure smooth plying of buses as per the said time-table, however, still the time slot which has been granted to the petitioners-Transport Societies, is being intervened by respondents-HRTC Depots.

3. Though this Court does not find any complaint, ever made by the petitioners-Transport Societies, post the fixing of new time-table, i.e. dated 16.10.2023, yet, in case the petitioners-Transport Societies, are still facing the problem on account of HRTC Buses being plied in the time slots given to them, they are at liberty to approach the competent authority concerned, by filing a comprehensive complaint alongwith supporting evidence.

4. In case such a complaint is filed by the petitioners-Transport Societies, the authority concerned, shall take a prompt action thereon, accordance with law and applicable rules.

5. **Disposed of**, with the abovesaid liberty and directions.

6. All pending application(s), if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
