1. Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023 is for issuance of directions to respondent nos.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in the captioned FIRs.

2. At the outset, learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of an affidavit of Umed Singh, HPS, DSP, Tohana, District Fatehabad, which is taken on record. He, on instructions from SI Umed Singh, submits that in FIR No.45 dated 30.01.2025, registered under Sections 111(2)(b), 115(2), 126(2), 190 and 191(2) of the BNS, 2023 (Section 109 of the BNS, 2023 added later on), at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad, the challan was presented on 29.03.2025 and the supplementary challan has been presented on 11.07.2025 and now the case is fixed for 31.07.2025 before the trial Court. He further submits that in FIR No.49 dated 31.01.2025, registered under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 190(2), 191(2) of the BNS, 2023, at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad, the challan was presented on 27.05.2025 and now the case is fixed for 25.09.2025 before the trial Court.

Keeping in view the fact that the challans have already been presented in both the FIRs, I dispose of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to pursue his remedies before the trial Court as available to him in accordance with law and he would also be at liberty to avail his remedy in case any further cause of action arises.
