1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.09 dated 16.01.2023 registered under Sections 323, 34, 354-A, 406, 498-A & 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Women Police Station, District Bhiwani (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise dated 24.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. Pursuant to receipt of advance copy of the petition, Mr. Gagandeep Singh Chhina, Asstt. A.G., Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-State and on instructions from SI Dharnali Devi, submits that there were total four accused in the FIR, out of which one Ajay Kant was found innocent during the investigation and the instant petition has been filed only on behalf of one accused and in view of the law laid down by the Division Bench of this Court in ***Rakesh Das Vs. State of Haryana : 2024(4) Law Herald 3141***, the petition filed for quashing of FIR on the basis of partial compromise is not maintainable.
