SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagrik Surakhsha Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'BNSS'), in a case arising out of FIR No.0083 dated 22.03.2025 under Sections 21, 27(a), 61 of NDPS Act, 1985, Police Station Civil Line Batala, District Gurdaspur.

2. Vide order dated 28.05.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating. The petitioner was also directed to cooperate with the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

3. On the instructions of ASI Gurmukh Singh, received through SI Gurmit Singh, learned State Counsel has stated that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and that presence of petitioner is not required for further investigation of the present case.



4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby allowed and the order dated 28.05.2025 granting interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute.
