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**SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (ORAL)**

1. Prayer in the instant petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to provide protection of lives and liberty to the petitioners, who have married against the wishes of the private respondents.

2. In compliance to the order dated 28.05.2025, status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punhana, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, dated 23.06.2025, has been filed in Court today. Same is taken on record. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

Paras 4, 5 & 6 of the status report read as under:-

**“4. That in this context, it is submitted that the enquiry upon the representation dated 27.05.2025 Annexure P-3 (bearing no. 3690/ORD dated 30.05.2025) was conducted by ASI Ratibhan, P.S. Punhana, Nuh. During the course of enquiry, the statements of the petitioners (Ruksar and Nasim Khan) as well as the private respondents (Wasidan and Asina) were recorded by ASI Ratibhan.**



5. That the petitioner no. 1 Ruksar stated that she has solemnized marriage with Nasim Khan as per Muslim rites on her own will. She and Nasim Khan had filed the present CRWP No. 5693 of 2025 before this Hon'ble Court for seeking protection. She further stated that now, they do not have any threat from anybody and they do not require any police protection. It is pertinent to mention here that the petitioner no. 1 Ruksar has stated that she and Nasim are living at her matrimonial house with her in-laws at Chandbas, Chirkhana Karoli, Distt. Alwar (Rajasthan). The statement of the petitioner no. 1 is attached herewith as Annexure R-1.

6. That the petitioner no. 2 Nasim Khan stated that he is already married with one Sahnaj and he is having dispute with her for a long time. Sehnaj lives in her parental house. He has solemnized marriage with Ruksar as per Muslim rites on his own will. He and Ruksar had filed the present CRWP No. 5693 of 2025 before this Hon'ble Court for seeking protection. He further stated that now, they do not have any threat from anybody and they do not require any police protection. The petitioner no. 2 further stated that he and Ruksar are now living with his parents at Village Chandbas, Chirkhana Karoli, Distt. Alwar (Rajasthan). He further stated that some days ago, he had gone to the house of his uncle and aunt (fufa and bua) at Village Baded, P.S. Sadar Punhana, Nuh for 10-15 days and then he had returned to his house. Now, both of them are living at Chandbas, Chirkhana Karoli, Distt. Alwar (Rajasthan). The statement of the petitioner no. 2 is attached herewith as Annexure R-2.”



3. In view of the facts recorded in the paragraphs, reproduced above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the prayer made in the instant petition, at this stage.
4. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of in terms of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners.
