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SHEEL NAGU, CJ. (Oral)

1. Present Public Interest Litigation has been filed by a stranger to the temple in question praying for a relief against the demolition, which he alleges, has been started by the Municipal Corporation, Faridabad and it is in the process of demolishing the boundary wall and the temple itself may be demolished very soon.

2. It is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that a civil suit has been instituted by *Pujari(s)*, etc. of the temple, which is pending adjudication since 2022.

3. In view of the above, when interests of the temple appear to have been taken care of by the *Pujari(s)*, etc. and the petitioner may



intervene in the said pending proceedings or institute his own civil suit (if permissible in law), we decline to interfere in the matter and leave it to the Civil Court to adjudicate upon the issue with regard to the temple, as expeditiously as possible.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
