1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 with a prayer for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0205 dated 21.12.2024, under Sections 333, 118(1), 115(2), 191(3), 190, 351(1), 351(3) of BNS, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur District Gurdaspur.

2. While granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail by this Court on 29.05.2025, this Court had noticed the following contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was named in the FIR, but as per the version, he caused simple injuries to the complainant on his back and foot. He further relies upon the orders Annexures P-2 and P-3 passed by this Court, whereby the concession of anticipatory bail have been granted to Rohit and Lakhwinder Singh @ Lakhwinder, co-accused. ”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated the submissions and further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation may not be required.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 29.05.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.

6. Pending application(s) stand(s) also disposed of.
