[1] The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of '*Mandamus*' directing the official respondents No. 2 to 4, respectively) to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondent No.5.

[2] Counsel for the petitioners confines his prayer only for issuance of a direction to decide the representation dated 22.05.2025 (Annexure P-4) by the Commissioner of Police, Sonipat i.e. respondent No.3. Counsel for the petitioners made another prayer that they wants to visit the police station to pursue their representation (Annexure P-4) along with their counsel.



[3] Notice of motion.

[4] Having received advance copy of the petition, Mr. Aashish Bishnoi, DAG, Haryana, appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4. Learned State counsel has informed that the representation/complaint (Annexure-P-4) has been received and same will be decided within three weeks and the State counsel has no objection, if the counsel representing the petitioners accompanied the petitioners in the police station.

[5] Keeping in view the innocuous prayer made, seeking written response from the respondents is dispensed with.

[6] In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the Commissioner of Police, Sonipat (respondent No. 3) to consider and decide the representation dated 22.05.2025 (Annexure P-4) and if some action is warranted, the needful be done in accordance with law, within a period of three weeks from the date of the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

[7] The State shall remain bound by its statement given in Court today.
