In the present petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of daily wage services and consider the case of the petitioner under the Old Pension Scheme in light of the order dated 01.09.2022 passed by respondent No.1 (Annexure P-7).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.1 to decide representation dated 13.06.2024 (Annexure P-10) submitted by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

4. Mr. Sanjeev Soni, Advocate, appears and files Power of Attorney on behalf of the respondents, which is taken on record. He does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation dated 13.06.2024 (Annexure P-10), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
