1. Both these cases involve similar issues and therefore are being
disposed of together.

2. Prayer made in the present petitions is for directing the respondents to



consider the claim of the petitioners for regularization, who are working under the Central Government Scheme.

3. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioners submit that in wake of stand taken by Union of India-respondent No.68, in the written statement dated 17.08.2020, they be granted liberty to submit a detailed representation before the respondents, taking all pleas that may be available to them in accordance with law, which may be directed to be decided in a time bound manner.

4. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

5. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, these petitions are hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case, petitioners submit a representation within a period of 04 weeks, the same shall be considered and decided, within a further period of 06 months, in accordance with law, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.

7. Pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
