[1]. By way of present revision petition, challenge has been laid to the order dated 18.05.2023 (Anneuxre P-10) passed by the learned District Judge, Rewari, vide which civil misc. appeal against order dated 26.09.2022 passed by the learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.) Rewari preferred at the instance of the petitioners was dismissed.

[2]. In the present case, based upon judgment and decree dated 03.03.2009, the respondents filed an execution application having invoked Order 21 Rule 32 CPC along with an application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC. Vide order dated 20.09.2022/26.09.2022, passed by the learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.) Rewari, an interim protection was granted in favour of the private respondents, thereby restraining the petitioners from demolishing the shop/kiosk of the private respondents/decreed-holders. Aggrieved thereof, the



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petitioners preferred misc. civil appeal, however the same was dismissed vide order dated 18.05.2023.

[3]. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the paper book, in the humble opinion of this Court since the execution application preferred at the instance of the private respondents is pending consideration before the learned Executing Court for 03.01.2026 for its final adjudication and interim protection has remained operative in favour of the private respondents for the past more than 03 years, it would not be appropriate to interfere with the interim protection awarded in favour of the private respondents rather the learned Executing Court is requested to expedite the proceedings in the execution proceedings preferred at the instance of the private respondents which are pending for the past more than 05 years and to conclude the same within two months of the date fixed i.e. 03.01.2026.

[4]. In view of aforesaid observation, the present revision petition is disposed of. Pending application(s), if any shall also stand disposed of.
