HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the official respondents to implement the warrants of possession dated 06.04.2016 (Annexure P-3), in view of the *Sanad Takseem* dated 16.03.2016 (Annexure P-2) and partition order dated 26.10.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Assistant Collector, Grade-1, Gidderbaha.

2. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a revision petition, bearing ROR No.418 of 2023, is pending adjudication before the learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab, wherein the

aforesaid *Sanad Takseem* dated 16.03.2016 has also been challenged. Accordingly, learned counsel seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to contest the said revision petition before the learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab. However, he further prays that time bound directions be issued to the learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab, for deciding the said revision petition.

3. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondents No.8 to 10 do not oppose the aforesaid request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid. However, considering that the *Sanad Takseem* in question pertains to the year 2016, the learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab is directed to make earnest endeavour to decide the revision petition (ROR No.418 of 2023) expeditiously and preferably within a period of six months from today, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all concerned parties.

5. The present writ petition is disposed of, accordingly.

6. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
