1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for direction to the respondents to release the arrears of pay and gratuity.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction be given to respondent No.4 to decide the representation dated 16.01.2025 (Annexure P-3), in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Vikas Arora, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and on the asking of the Court, he also accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.4. He does not oppose the prayer, as made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.



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5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the representation dated 16.01.2025 (Annexure P-3), submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is held entitled for grant of relief as per the law as claimed in the representation dated 16.01.2025 (Annexure P-3), the same be also released within a period of 02 months thereafter.

6. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
