The present writ petition has been filed seeking quashing of the impugned Transfer Order/Movement Order dated 24.05.2025 vide which the petitioner was transferred from Faridkot to Kishanganj North Bengal as the case of the petitioner is fully covered by the office Memorandum dated 11.03.2024.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has submitted his representation dated 26.05.2025 (Annexure P-8) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2-Director General, Border Security Force, New Delhi is directed to consider and decide the representation

dated 26.05.2025 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Indresh Goel, Senior Panel Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. He, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 26.05.2025 (Annexure P-8) by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of two months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In the event, the decision goes against the petitioner, the same shall be kept in abeyance for a period of two weeks from the date of order.
