1. The prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to fix the seniority of the petitioners, as per the merit determined by the Selection Committee, as has been done in the case of similarly situated candidates, who were appointed in the same Department, vide order dated 22.04.2016, which has been produced in Court and a copy thereof handed over to learned State counsel. He thus, at this stage, on instructions from the petitioners, prays that a direction be given to the respondents to consider their claim, taking into account the aforesaid order in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.

2. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners, taking note of the aforesaid order, within a period of 6 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so,

after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
