1. This is a petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.137 dated 02.05.2024 registered under Sections 420,406 and 120-B of IPC at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal.
2. This Court, vide order dated 19.08.2025, had directed the petitioners to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the SHO/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS (erstwhile Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.)
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 19.08.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined and cooperated with the investigation.



4. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI- Manoj Kumar (Police Station-Hathin, Palwal) states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.
5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 19.08.2025 is **made absolute**. The petitioners shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
