There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. The first order of dismissal for non-prosecution and default in appearance was passed on 18.04.2017. However on 22.05.2017 the counsel appeared to get his petition restored. The petition was restored to be heard on merits. Counsel again abandoned the case on 06.10.2017 and 05.02.2018. On 23.05.2018, the case was adjourned by order to 10.12.2018 and today also no one is present to press the petition.

The petition is again dismissed for non-prosecution and in default of appearance. This time there will be a restraint on entertaining any application for restoration in this case unless a sum of Rs.10,000/- is deposited by the petitioner in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and proof of payment produced before the application is allowed to be listed for hearing.
