The instant Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing order dated 18.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) only to the extent that the petitioner has been asked to apply for re-issuance of his passport.
