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This application has been filed under Section 151 CPC for fixing the actual date of hearing and disposing the present writ petition in view of judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.18261 of 2018 titled as **“Tej Paul Wadhwa Vs. State of Punjab through Secretary, Government of Punjab, Department of Water Supply and Sanitation, Civil Sect. Chandigarh and others”** decided on 15.10.2024.

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1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue raised in the present petition has already been decided by this Court while passing order in CWP No.18261 of 2018 titled as “**Tej Paul Wadhwa Vs. State of Punjab through Secretary, Government of Punjab, Department of Water Supply and Sanitation, Civil Sect. Chandigarh and others**” decided on 15.10.2024 hence, the present petition be also disposed of in the same terms.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioner claiming the benefit as decided by this Court in **Tej Paul (supra)**, the said representation will be considered in light of the judgment in **Tej Paul (supra)** and appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order and in case it is found feasible to grant the relief, the appropriate relief will be granted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not granting the relief claimed by the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be



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disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file a representation before the authorities concerned.

- 5. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
