1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to release the ex-gratia grant, GPF and other pensionary benefits of deceased-Giano alias Agyanwanti, to the petitioner.
2. Learned State counsel while referring to para 2 of preliminary submissions of the reply filed by way of affidavit of the Medical Superintendent, Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Majitha, Road, Amrtisar, dated 21.08.2023, submits that it is after the dismissal of RSA-697-2000, on 05.04.2018, on the basis of compromise effected between the parties, that the petitioner, daughter-in-law of the deceased-employee, was made the amount of GPF on 23.01.2023, as also gratuity on 03.02.2025 and she was entitled to no amount of leave encashment and

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also similarly to ex-gratia as the required affidavit attested by the Ist Class Magistrate was not submitted by her, contents of para 3 of preliminary submissions of the reply have not been controverted by filing any replication. Insofar as, the deposit link insurance (DLI) is concerned, learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the same has been sent for sanction and shall be released within a period of 2 months.

3. Disposed of accordingly, reserving the petitioner with a liberty to represent the respondents in case any grievance still subsists.
