1. This is first petition under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.74, dated 27.02.2020, registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad, under Sections 21(b) and 27(a) of NDPS Act, 1985.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel have been heard and material on file has been perused.

3. In the present case, petitioner was initially released on anticipatory bail but during the trial he absented on 01.12.2022 and his bail was cancelled. Thereafter, he was re-arrested on 24.09.2024 and he is in custody since then. The trial is progressing at a slow pace and since presence of petitioner has already been secured and he is in custody for around one year after his re-arrest, no useful purposed will be served by detaining him in custody any more. However, Trial Court can impose stringent conditions so as to secure his presence.



4. Having regard to the aforesaid factual position, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the bail application is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
