The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to refix the petitioner's pension by granting the benefit of annual increment in the last year of retirement.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before respondent no.3. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.3 is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 03.04.2025, Annexure P-5, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 03.04.2025, will be decided by respondent no.3-Director, Secondary Education Haryana, in terms of law laid down by the Division Bench in a batch of petitions with lead case CWP-14627-2024 titled *Mahabir Singh Tanwar v. State of Haryana and others* by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within three months.



- 5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
- 6. Ordered accordingly.
- 7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
