1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of respondents No.3 to 5, who are acting at the behest of private respondents No.6 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 27.05.2025 (Annexure P-9) to Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh-respondent No.2 and he shall be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissionerate of Police, Mini Secretariat, Ferozepur Road, Ludhiana-respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 27.05.2025 (Annexure P-9) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two weeks from today.
