Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for quashing the Look Out Circular and its performa (Annexure P-4) issued by respondent no.1 on request of respondents no.2 and 3, in case FIR No.15, dated 13.03.2022, registered at P.S. Women Police Station, Sector 51, Gurugram.

2. Today, learned Additional Solicitor General of India, informed this Court that LOC issued against the present petitioner has already been withdrawn.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has filed a status report dated 05.07.2025, by way of an affidavit of Ms. Surinder Kaur,



ACP, CAW East & West Gurugram, on behalf of respondent no.2, which is taken on record, with a copy thereof, supplied to learned counsel opposite.

4. In view of the specific averment made in paragraph no.6 of the status report (*supra*), and the statement suffered by learned Additional Solicitor General of India, the prayer, as made in the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

5. **Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.**
