KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, a challenge is thrown to the show cause notice dated 24.04.2025 (Annexure P-15), as issued by the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana (respondent No.2), as well as the proceedings arising therefrom. Challenge is also thrown to the order dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure P-16), as passed by the Registrar General, Firms and Societies, Haryana (respondent No.3), on an appeal No.699 of 2025, being preferred by the petitioner.

2. Earlier, the District Registrar, Firms and Societies, Gurugram, by drawing an order dated 16.04.2025, in exercise of the powers vested in it, under Section 59(1) of the Haryana Registration and Regulations of Societies (HRRS) Act, 2012, has forwarded the issue of cancellation of registration of the society, in question. Further, the society was directed not to undertake



any activity related to membership, finance or any other issue until the case is decided by the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana. In pursuance thereof, the show cause notice dated 24.04.2025 (Annexure P-15), issued by the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner/Society, had earlier filed a review application under Section 79(5) of the HRRS Act/Rules, 2012, and the said application was allowed, and the District Registrar, Firms and Societies, Gurugram, has sought specific permission to review its order dated 16.04.2025, as the said order was earlier passed on patent factual errors. He further submitted that despite the order dated 19.05.2025, whereby, the permission for review has been sought from the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana, who is still pursuing the proceedings under the impugned show cause notice. Finally, he submits that the petitioner has also filed an appeal, raising this plea before the learned Appellate Authority concerned. However, the learned Appellate Authority concerned, chose not to take any action thereupon, and considering the fact that the order dated 16.04.2025, is already under review, the appeal was not adjudicated on merits.

4. This Court has considered the submissions, as made by the learned counsel for the parties, and is of the considered opinion that the petitioner instead of filing the instant motion, ought to have appeared before the learned State Registrar concerned, and would have apprised about the supervening events i.e. the order dated 19.05.2025, as passed by the learned State Registrar concerned.

5. In view of the above facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, at this stage, is relegated to the learned State Registrar of Societies,

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Haryana, to raise its grievance, which has been cast through the instant petition.

6. In case, the petitioner approaches the learned State Registrar of Societies, Haryana, within a period of 15 days, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, the latter, shall make an endeavour to decide the same within two months, thereafter.

7. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**.

8. The petitioner is at liberty to file an apt application before the learned State Registrar of Societies, Haryana, seeking any restraintment of coercive action, in pursuance to the show cause notice (supra).
