1. The main grievance which propelled the present petitioner to approach this Court by casting instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is the indolent and lackadaisical approach of Sub Divisional, Magistrate, Zira, Ferozepur (respondent no.3), in not deciding his complaint filed under the provisions of Section 133 of BNSS, 2023, dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-5).

2. On an advance notice, Mr. Teevar Sharma, AAG, Punjab, has caused appearance on behalf of the respondents-State, who informs this Court, on instruction imparted to him by SDM Gurmeet Singh, that in fact the complaint (*supra*), has already been adjudicated vide order dated 20.05.2025, whereby, the same was ordered to be filed.

3. In view of the above specific statement suffered by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this



Court, to withdraw the instant petition, with liberty to challenge the order (*supra*), vide which complaint has been ordered to be filed.

4. Consequently, the instant petition, stands **dismissed** as withdrawn, with aforesaid liberty.
