Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the official respondent authorities to restore the water course at Moga No.111730/L Rajwah Sirsa Major, constructed in rectangle No.140 Killa No. 5, 6, 15, 16 and 25 in the area of Village Jodhka, Tehsil Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa, which was running since last more than 40 years and the petitioners were getting canal water from Sirsa Major Distributor at Moga No.111730/L to irrigate their agricultural land of about 19 Acres.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time,

submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Canal Authorities for seeking restoration of the water course, which according to the petitioners have been demolished.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

4. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
