The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.3 to issue Police Clearance Certificate of the petitioner for renewal of the passport of the petitioner, which was expired on 20.11.2024.
