At the outset, learned State counsel apologises for wrong statement having been made on 18.08.2025, on instructions from the official concerned, regarding filing of affidavit in the Registry on 11.08.2025. The apology is accepted being *bona fide*.

2. The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents, especially respondents no.1 to 3, to permit the petitioner to adopt Old Pension Scheme (OPS) in view of instructions no.1/1/2004-1 Pension (FD) dated 08.05.2023, Annexure P-2.

3. Learned State counsel has received instructions from the fifth respondent vide memo dated 20.08.2025, and submits that in case the petitioner re-submits her case for grant of benefits under the OPS to the officer concerned



with all the requisite documents within two weeks from today, it will be considered in accordance with law, and the admissible benefits will be released to her within three months therefrom.

4. In view of statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
5. Ordered accordingly.
6. In case the order is not complied with within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
