1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and minor daughters of petitioner No.1 from danger at the hands of respondent No.5 to 10.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Jind to consider and decide the representations dated 19.04.2025 (addressed to D.G.P, Haryana) 20.05.2025 & 27.05.2025 (Annexures P-1 to P-3) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection to their lives and personal liberty.
3. Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

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4. Ms. Priyanka Sadar, A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

5. Accordingly, and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Jind that if any such representations, as indicated above, are indeed pending consideration, the same shall be dealt with expeditiously, preferably within a period of one month, in accordance with law and in the meanwhile, respondent No.4-S.H.O. Police Station Julana, District Jind shall ensure to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners
