1. Through the instant petition, a prayer is made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.239 dated 19.11.2020 (Annexure P-1), under Section 15 (c) and 25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar Rural.

2. The instant petition was filed during the vacations and the coordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 10.06.2025, had issued the notice of motion in the instant petition, with a mandamus upon the respondent/State of Punjab, to file a written response regarding the complicity of the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the State has filed the short reply dated 17.06.2025, by way of affidavit of Mr. Kulwant Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Adampur, District Jalandhar Rural, on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab, today in the Court. The same is



taken on the record.

- 4. Perusal of the reply (supra), reflects that the recovery effected from the present petitioner does fall under the ambits of commercial quantity.
- 5. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today in the Court. Similar was the position on the previous occasions as well.
- 6. At this stage, this Court, can safely presume that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition.
- 7. Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed for want of prosecution.**
